 - a. Current Balance: \$50,570.15
 - b. Budget will be ready for next month's meeting.
- 4. Trustees Report
 - a. Library Campus Plan: Erin presented a detailed plan for a Story Walk, Historical Garden, Reflective Garden and Conservation Garden. Board approved to move forward with this and will plan to put some of this funding in the 2025 budget. The budget is around \$80,000 for the total plan. Erin is working on some potential grants.
 - b. First action step will be to edit the current garden up front and start putting some of these plants in the Story Walk.
 - c. Erin found a landscaping person to do this at a reasonable rate.
 - d. Will look for volunteers to help.

 - a. Vernal Pools program completed

 - ii. There was a follow-up with the conservation commission to see vernal pools in the area.

 - iii. Maybe create a little card to give with museum passes.
 - iv. Work a little more on social media. Maybe post in the Friends of Hampton Falls FB group.
 - v. Have a donation box with a blurb next to it at events and also maybe in the library all the time.
- j. Artist Reception Idea
 - i. There is some local artwork at the library and there is a plan to have this be rotating every 2-4 months.
 - ii. Joanna suggested the Friends consider having an artist reception.
 - iii. One idea would be to create a membership drive around art, chocolate and wine. Possibly in October. Will discuss this more in June.
- k. Summer Reading
 - i. Joanna has spreadsheets ready to send out for the Friends to help with summer reading prizes.
 - ii. The Friends can create a Friends Basket as a prize, maybe a craft basket. Beeswax, candle wicks, maybe local honey. Beth has baskets. If any friends have items that would be good for a basket, please let Donna know.
 - iii. Joanna will provide the letter that the library uses for solicitation.
 - iv. Leah told us about a new program for Summer Reading given by the USS Albacore program on morse code and semaphore.
 - v. NH State is doing a scavenger hunt program with lots of fun prizes.

- 7. Mission Statement Brainstorming
 - a. New Mission Statement Draft:
